1. Offering and attendance.
2. Commandments.

3. Review PUF W TAT.
Spring v. Fall
Appointments and rehearsals.
Rains. Early and latter.
Passover= Crucifixion, sparing firstborn, recognizing danger
Unleavened Bread=in grave, fled Egypt, repentance
Firstfruits=Resurrection, Red Sea, salvation, giving first/best
Leaven = sin. Last week's lesson. What does leaven do?
Weeks = Law given, Spirit given
Trumpets = Rapture, in the future.
Atonement = Day of Judgment.
4. Do you like to go camping?
Tabernacles is kind of like a camping trip.
One of three pilgrimage festivals. What are the others?
Announced with trumpet: shofar.
Everybody goes up to celebrate, camps on the hills outside Jerusalem. 7 days.
Review the sevens. Every 7 years read the law.
Deut. 31:9-13.
5. Review the Tabernacle. God lives there.
Wilderness wandering. Book.
Our tabernacle is our body.
God will live with us in the Millennium.
6. Read my book.

7. Sukkah. Show pictures.
First mention: Genesis 33:17.
Directions and photos.
Guests: Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Aaron, David
Eighth day, everyone prays for rain.
Our rainy season usually begins by August.

8. Four species: Read Neh. 8:14-17.
etrog: citrus fruit like lemon but sweet, smells/tastes good.
Coasts and valleys
Palm: date palm, sweet fruits but no smell. Deserts.
Myrtle: sweet smell but no fruit. Mountains.
Willow: no fruit, no smell. Waterways
Shake the pretend etrog & lulav. E W N S Up Down
Shake in procession around the synagogue and the recitation of Psalm 118. (Read together)
