Feast of Weeks

Get ready: Bibles marked, honey and stir sticks, feast booklets, cheesecake, candles, bread, wine

Unleavened Bread=in grave, fled Egypt, repentance
Firstfruits=Resurrection, Red Sea, salvation, giving first/best
Leaven = sin. Last week's lesson. What does leaven do?

Redemptive Weeks

1. 7 days = Sabbath
2. $7 \times 7 + 1$ = Feast of Weeks
3. 7 months = Feast calendar
4. 7 years = Sabbatical for land
5. $7 \times 7 + 1$ years = Jubilee
6. 7 millenniums = millennial rest

Jesus arose on Firstfruits and stayed around 40 days, then ascended. He had promised to send the Holy Spirit after He left.

Luke 3:16 John answered them all, “I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

John 16:7 But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

Ten days later, the Spirit came on Pentecost.

Acts 2:33 Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear.

Firstfruits of barley last week (for animals, not easy to separate)

Firstfruits of wheat and end of barley harvest

Weeks waved two loaves of the finest leavened bread

Timing, should always be on Sunday
