Atonement

Get ready: Bibles marked, feast booklets, quizzes run off, commandments run off and cut, Kol Nidre in tape player.

1. Offering and attendance.
2. Commandments. Review quiz.
3. Review PUF W TAT.
Spring v. Fall
Appointments and rehearsals.
Rains. Early and latter.
Passover= Crucifixion, sparing firstborn, recognizing danger
Unleavened Bread=in grave, fled Egypt, repentance
Firstfruits=Resurrection, Red Sea, salvation, giving first/best
Leaven = sin. What does leaven do?
Weeks = Law given, Spirit given
Trumpets = Rapture, in the future.
4. Tell the story of Mt. Sinai. Law, tabernacle, sacrifices
Passover, Unleavened Bread, Firstfruits, Weeks
Why? To restore our relationship with God. (Chain)
Broken because of rebellion, leaven, sin.
Atonement means covering, reconciliation. At-one-ment
Sample of life here. Life that is truly life (I Tim. 6:19)
5. Why the law? All those rules?
Tells us what God expects of us.
Makes us realize we can't do it on our own.
Like a mirror.
Two covenants, testaments.
Law came through Moses, grace & truth...John 1:17
6. Atonement requires innocent blood.
Lev. 17:11: For the life of a creature is in the blood...
Genesis 3: Adam and Eve

7. Tabernacle design: draw out and show picture.
Mercy seat also translated “atonement cover.”
8. Read my feasts book.
9. Read Hebrews 9 and 10. Shadow and substance.
Symbolism of tabernacle (body), holy place (soul), most holy place (spirit). Copy of tabernacle in heaven.

Blood of goat	Blood of Jesus
Goat for Azazel	Descended to hell
Earthly tabernacle	Heavenly tabernacle (9:11)
Curtain	Body (Heb. 10:20)
Atonement cover	Where he laid (Jn 20:10-12)
High priest never sits	Jesus sat down (Heb. 10:12)
